MINUTES OF ANNUAL PARISH MEETING HELD ON 21st APRIL 2010 AT THE PARISH ROOMS, VICARAGE LANE, LITTLE EATON AT 7.30PM.

0410.01 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE: Alan Machell, Tom Parr and John Easter

0410.02 The Chairman sought - and received from all present – confirmation that the Annual Parish Meeting Minutes for 15th April 2009 were a true record, this was unanimously **RESOLVED** and they were accordingly signed-off

0410.03.1 The Chairman went through the Annual Report of the Council, and invited observations or questions from those present but none were forthcoming, it was unanimously **RESOLVED** to receive the Annual Report of the Council.

0410.03.2 The Chairman went through the Audited Statement of Accounts for the year ended 31st March 2009, and reported that they were in a healthy state.

0410.03.3 The Chairman gave an indication on the finances for 2009-10 were in good order, however the cost of building the Village Hall is taking a large sum out of the outstanding balance.

0410.04. All accounts and reports for 2008-09 were include in the aforementioned Annual Report

0410.05 The Charity Accounts for Bates and Tempest were included in the Annual Report.

0410.06 Cllr. Carol Hart answered a couple of questions from Cllr Grundy regarding her report.

0410.07 Cllrs. Alan Summerfield and Eileen Knight's Annual Borough Council Report was included within the Parish Report. They also stated that the Mayor of Erewash for this year will be Robert Parkinson.

0410.08 The Parish Clerk reported that no written notices of resolutions had been received.

0410.09 A member of the public asked if a white line would be painted down one side of Vicarage Lane when the Village Hall is completed to prevent cars parking on both sides of the road and blocking it. Cllr Adams responded that the booking forms which would be available on the web site from 22nd April had a clause stating users of the hall must use the car park and not the road for parking.

The School Governor's Report will be prepared by Tom Parr next year who has replaced Tim Whitehouse.

Cllr Norman Grundy thanked Simon Downing on behalf of the Parish Council for the time and tremendous effort he has put into obtaining funding and organizing the building of the Village Hall.

Cllr Simon Downing stated that the Village Hall should be completed by 1st May and bookings are now being taken, there is a link on the Parish Council website to obtain a booking form, a form can also be obtained by contacting himself or Brian Adams.

On closing the meeting Simon Downing thanked members of the Council and Public for attending the meeting.

There being no other business, the Chairman closed the Annual Parish Meeting at 8.11 pm.
